Ombudsman for Children's Office (OCO)




The Ombudsman for Children's Office (OCO) is an independent office. The OCO was set up under a law called the Ombudsman for Children Act 2002.



Under this law, the Ombudsman for Children has two main roles:

to deal with complaints made by or for children and young people about the actions of public organisations.

to promote the rights and welfare of children and young people under 18 years old living in Ireland.



Three-Year Strategic Plan 2019–2021

Objectives and Actions:

The OCO's work to promote children's rights and welfare includes:

- finding out what children and young people are concerned about and highlighting their opinions to the Government and other people who make decisions that affect them;
- supporting people, including children and young people, to find out about children's rights and how those rights can be respected, protected and fulfilled and where

Vision

We want to see an Ireland where children's rights are respected, protected and fulfilled and where

- giving advice to the Government and others to help make sure laws and plans affecting children and young people respect children's rights;
- encouraging public organisations to work in ways that promote children and young people's rights and welfare; and

Compassionate – we care about children and young people and want to see their lives improved.

Independent – our independence is important so we can say the things that need to be said and hold public organisations to account.

- accessible – we are open to listening to children and young people and the adults who care and work with them.
- authoritative – when we speak out on behalf of children and young people we do so in a confident way informed by our research and backed up by the law that created the OCO.

Actions

- 1.1 We will continue to develop and implement initiatives to increase awareness among public and other organisations, members of the public and children and young people of children's rights and the OCO, including our role as a redress mechanism. We will focus in particular on engaging with groups who may find the OCO harder to reach.
- 1.2 We will encourage a child-centred and transparent approach to decision-making through all our engagements with public organisations.

- 2.1 We will support capacity building among relevant public organisations to implement policies, procedures and practices that are consistent with child-centred public administration, including with regard to complaints handling.
- 2.2 We will work on thematic issues, including issues children and young people are concerned about, in order to promote children and young people's rights and support learning by public and other organisations.

- 3.1 We will continue to pursue the progressive realisation of rights of vulnerable groups of children and young people, in particular children with disabilities, children experiencing mental health and homeless children. We will also pay particular attention to children in Direct Provision and those in the Traveller and Roma communities.
- 3.2 We will support international and European monitoring mechanisms in their work to hold the State to account for its actions and decisions concerning children's rights.

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This means that as an Office we are committed to providing a high quality professional service and will, at all times treat you politely, respectfully and with dignity.

We will continue to develop the OCO as a well-functioning and effective independent statutory body.

Actions

- 4.1 We will continue to foster a positive and encouraging work environment within the OCO, including by supporting the continued professional development of staff.

- 4.3 We will strive to improve our accessibility and inclusivity to all.

Agus eagraíochtaí poiblí á dtabhairt chun cuntas againn bainfimid úsáid as na cumhachtai atá againn sa díl agus bainfimid úsáid as meicniúcháin a mhéid is atáimid in ann chun é sin a bhaint amach.

Gníomhaíochtaí

1.1 Leanfaimid orainn ag forbairt agus ag cur tionscnamh i bhfeidhm chun feasacht a mhéadú i measc eagraíochtaí poiblí agus eagraíochtaí eile, baill den phobal agus leanáí agus daoine óga maidir le cearta leanáí a bhaint amach.

Cuirfimid ceisteanána sa chás nach dtarlóidh sé seo agus aithneoidim dea-chleachtas nuair a bhíonn sé solleir.

Gníomhaíochtaí

1.2 Leanfaimid orainn le cearta grúpaí leanáí agus daoine óga leachailleacha a bhaint amach, go háirithe leanáí faoi mhíchumas, leanáí a bhfuil fadhbanna meabhairshláinte acu agus leanáí gan díean. Leagfaimid aird ar leith ar leanáí i Soláthar Díreach agus leanáí ón Lucht Siúil.

Údarásach

2.1 Spreagfaimid cur chuige atá diríthe ar leanáí agus déanaimid é ar bhealach muiníneach atá tréadearach trínár rannpháirtiach go léir le grúpa a mheasann go bhfuil sé níos deacracht ar an OCO.
