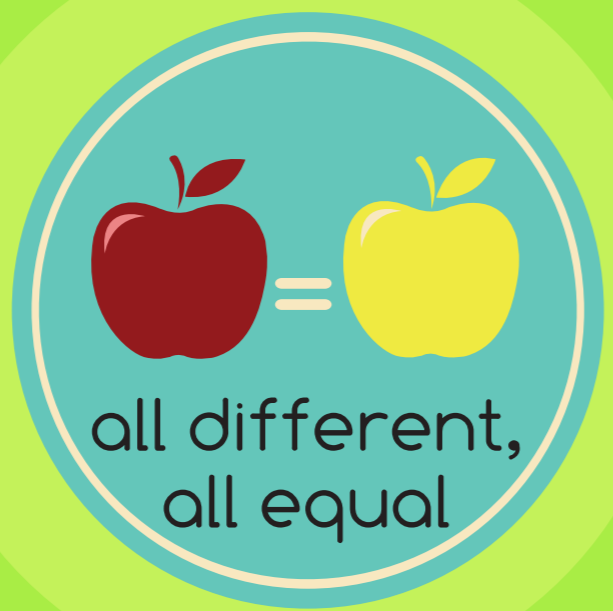


UN Convention on the Rights of the Child
